### The 8th of March -Women's Day

Nowadays Women's Day is considered to be an international holiday, however, the beginning of this celebration goes back to 1908 when the women of New York City held their first meeting as a social political event. In 1909 it was announced as a national holiday in America.

The idea of international celebrating of the women's rights belongs to a German communist activist **Clara Zetkin.** (By the way, her ashes were placed in the Kremlin Wall Necropolis in Red Square in 1933.)

Russian women observed their first International Women's Day in 1913. It was declared a national holiday in the Soviet Union in 1917.

Today the focus of celebration is different. In some countries the day lost its political flavour and became simply an occasion for people to express their love for women. Thus, it is similar to a mixture of Mother's Day and Valentine's Day. In other regions the political and human rights theme runs strong. Some people wear purple ribbons to bring out the social importance of the struggle of women for their rights worldwide.
